



IMVUBU | UNIT 4

Imvubu, which means hippo in Zulu, is a fully self-catering thatched log cabin that is raised on stilts. Being raised off the ground ensures that this is the perfect spot for wildlife viewing, with daily visits from a variety of birds, and many animals that come for a drink at Crocodile River. Favourites include huge herds of elephant, and buffalo, which enjoy taking a wallow in the refreshing water.

Imvubu is a one-bedroom log cabin, which sleeps four guests. The sleeping configuration offers a king-sized bed, and fold out sleeper couch, which can be made up upon request by the staff. The cabin is air-conditioned and has an en-suite glass shower and basin with a separate toilet.

A kitchenette, and dining table is situated on the private viewing deck, which is used as the living room area, where you can enjoy the sounds of the African bush while preparing your meal.

A barbeque (braai) area is situated in front of the log cabin.
